#### COMPLETION OF ENTITLEMENT ISSUE

Collaborate Corporation Limited (ASX:CL8) (**Collaborate** or the **Company**) is pleased to announce that it has completed the partially underwritten non-renounceable entitlement offer of shares and free-attaching options pursuant to the prospectus dated 14 September 2020 (**Entitlement Issue**).

A total of 261,636,111 New Shares and 52,327,203 Options were issued on 30 October 2020, representing take-up of 68% of the total Shares offered under the Entitlement Issue and raising \$2,354,725 before costs.

The Entitlement Issue was offered to shareholders registered at the Record Date of 18 September 2020 with a registered address in Australia and New Zealand (**Eligible Shareholders**) on the basis of one (1) New Share for every three (3) Shares held, together with one (1) free attaching option for every five (5) New Shares subscribed for and issued. The free attaching options will be unquoted, exercisable at \$0.015 each and expire on 31 October 2022 (**Options**).

The Entitlement Issue is partially underwritten by existing shareholders of the Company namely SG Fleet Management Pty Limited and Willoughby Capital Pty Ltd as trustee for the Willoughby Capital Trust, alongside Directors of the Company Adrian Bunter and Chris Noone and Chief Operating Officer, Ben Hershman (the **Underwriters**).

CEO and Executive Director, Mr Chris Noone, said "We appreciate the continued support of all shareholders who applied for shares, as well as the Underwriters and major shareholders of the Company. Both SG Fleet and Willoughby Capital provided additional funds by also underwriting the offer".

An Appendix 2A follows this announcement and confirms the issued capital of the Company on a pre-consolidation basis following completion of the Entitlement Issue.

Following completion of the Entitlement Issue, the Company has 122,281,132 Shares and 24,456,010 Options available to be issued prior to 23 January 2021 which are available to investors pursuant to the shortfall offer under the prospectus dated 14 September 2020.
